A number of socio-economic problem exist such as mass poverty, indebtedness, mass unemployment lack of skills, low levels of educational attainments, low levels of literacy, migration exploitation of landless labourer child labour, a high school dropout rate low status of women poor health of women violence against women castiesm and atrocities against daliths.

After using energy-efficient lighting, it is important that is properly disposed of. Nearly 250 numbers of women folk were attending at Tiruvannamalai Full moon Girivalam time. Every full-moon time nearly 3-4 lakhs pilgrims were come together at this place. At that time we have conducted this programme.

2. HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAMME: -

AYUSH, namely Ayurveda, Unani, Yoga and Naturopathy have been serving the mankind since thousands of years. Siddha system of medicine is prevalent in Tamilnadu and its adjacent areas. For convenience of administration, Homoeopathy has been added along with these systems. In spite of the great progress made by modern scientific system of medicine, these systems are still widely used by masses in areas like life style diseases (mental stress, heart disease, bronchial asthma, diabetes mellitus etc.), Liver disorders, Gastro intestinal disturbances, Ano-rectal disorders, Respiratory diseases, Joint disorders, Skin diseases and various functional disturbances, Psychosomatic disorder. These systems are sometimes used as alternative therapies in cases where the modern drugs have their limitations in use and also result side effects caused. The medicines of these systems are also used sometimes as adjuvant to prevent the side effects of modern medicine on liver, kidney, bone marrow etc. There is a growing interest in the world towards herbal remedies. We have conducted Awareness on Siddha, Ayurvedic and Unani medicine in Sirurvallur village.



3. CHILDRENS CAMP :-

MMDA has conducted children Camp. 30 School drops ours are selected and coaching classes. We learn the beneficiaries signing, reading newspaper, etc. We have provided with Books and Notes, guides to the beneficiaries at free of cost.

4. OLD AGED HOME :-

MMDA is the Rest Home for aged people, with view that are growing problems among the rural families in India due to modernization and fast paced livings on present days. Family bonded and love are broken now a days, where the aged parents are left alone by the children and also due to over burden with works of this present day society or due to migration to cities and abroad for works and income generation by this young generation, many of the elder s are left alone with no care for medicine, love and other basic amenities in their rest of life. Hence MMDA is one of the key initiatives of Dr. Ms. C.M.E. MATHEWS MEMORIAL DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION meant to support the deserving elders in their rest of life, but with a focus on Short Time Stays until their family is counselled and the elders are reinstated back into their regular social life. MMDA campus is situation in an ecofriendly atmosphere, free from pollution.in KALASAPAKKAM, Taluk HQ, MMDA has very good infrastructure with 4 rooms with 2 Kitchen and bathrooms & Toilets with all facilities, two Halls, well equipped and facilitated with care.
